Lancaster, **Pa.** - Barley Snyder attorney <u>Luke T. Weber</u> has been appointed to the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania's Committee on Rules of Evidence. His role is effective October 1, 2022.

The <u>Committee on Rules of Evidence</u> was formed in 1998 by the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania to aid and advise the court with issuing general rules governing all court proceedings in the state. The committee provides recommendations to the court regarding evidence law matters by monitoring the application of rules and developments in case law as well as identifying areas in which rules of evidence should be revised or clarified.

"It is humbling to have received an appointment from the Supreme Court to serve on the Committee," Weber said. "The Rules of Evidence are integral to what we do as trial attorneys, and I look forward to working with the Committee and aiding the Court in its ongoing review process."

Committee members are appointed by the Supreme Court typically for a term of six years. They must be knowledgeable about the Pennsylvania Rules of Evidence and have trial court experience. The committee typically consists of a small number of judges and attorneys throughout the state. Hon. Wendy G. Rothstein of Montgomery County has also been appointed at this time.

"This appointment is a tremendous honor and a testament to Luke's experience and skill as a litigator," said Managing Partner Jeff Lobach. "Since 2012, Luke has been involved in more than 100 cases across the Commonwealth in state and federal courts. As a practicing litigator, engaged daily in court proceedings, Luke is well-suited to serve on the Rules Committee.
