Hanover, Pa. - Barley Snyder is pleased to announce that <u>Daniel M. Frey</u> has been elected to the board of directors of <u>Main Street Hanover Inc.</u> and has been named the board's vice chairman.

"As a nonprofit, Main Street Hanover will be eligible for different grants, be able to receive donations more efficiently and expand what we do as an organization. I'm very proud to be able to take this leadership position that will help shape the future of the downtown and the borough."

Frey is a former assistant district attorney in York County and a former past president of the board of directors of the York County Bar Association. He is active in other community groups in Hanover, including a 2017 election to the board of directors of the Hanover Public Library Association Inc. He is also a past president of the board of directors of the Hanover Area YMCA and currently is serving on the board of trustees for the Hanover Area YMCA.
